## FAIR RULES AND REGULATIONS

## FIRE SAFETY & TRAFFIC

Fire regulations and traffic management requires that exhibit floor aisles be open at all times. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping the aisles near his/her booth free of congestion caused by demonstrations or other promotions. All exhibit decorations and materials such as drape, carpet, etc. must be fire resistant. The painting and spraying of toxic or flammable substances is prohibited, as is the use of flammable liquids, compressed air, dangerous chemicals, and open flame. Electrical wiring placed on the floor must be covered or taped down.

## LIABILITY

Exhibitors are liable for any damage to floors, walls, or columns of the exhibit venue. Show Management will hold the exhibitor responsible for removal of all tape or adhesives placed on the exhibit floor and walls.

## **GRATUITIES**

Any attempts made by an employee to solicit a gratuity for any service should be reported immediately to a Show Management Supervisor. Tipping is not appropriate.
